A. GENERAL INFORMATION

A.1 COMPETITION VENUE

Kontiolahti Biathlon Stadium is located on the shores of Lake Höytiäinen in the municipality of Kontiolahti. The stadium is 14 km from the city centre of Joensuu and 25 km from Joensuu airport. Kontiolahti Biathlon Stadium is located 120 meters above the sea level. The tracks vary between 89 and 129 meters above the sea level.

D. TRANSPORTATION

D.1 TRANSPORTATION FROM AIRPORT/TRAIN STATION

D.2 TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM THE STADIUM

You can use your own transport for travelling to/from the Kontiolahti Biathlon Stadium. However, if needed, the organiser offers free transportation, too. The media shuttle buses will leave and arrive from/to Joensuu City in front of the media hotels "Scandic Joensuu" (address: Kirkkokatu 20, Joensuu) and "Sokos Hotel Vaakuna" (address: Torikatu 20, Joensuu). Note! The transport service is based only on requests

















in advance and final timetables are made as a combination of single requests. The estimated driving time in one direction is app. 20 minutes.

We kindly ask you to leave the requests at the latest one day before the requested transportation.

E. MEDIA AREAS AND SERVICES

E.1 PARKING IN THE STADIUM

The parking capacity in the stadium is limited during the event. Media has its own parking area close to the media entrance of the Kontiolahti Stadium (follow "Media" signs when arriving). Parking permits for the media parking area must be pre-ordered and will be handed out at the accreditation office.

E.2 MEDIA CENTRE

The Media Centre (see #11 on the map below) offers a fast WLAN network and an optional LAN-cabling.

E.3 I-ZONES IN THE MEDIA CENTER

Starting from this season, press conferences after each race will not be conducted. Instead, the Top 3 athletes in each race will gather on the "I-Zone" (interview zone) inside the media centre. The athletes will have separate sit-down zones and can be interviewed by the media after the competitions. The new set-up with journalists' direct access to the athletes will help to create a more relaxed atmosphere and will provide more comfortable conditions for both: the media and the interviewee.

For safety measures and in order to protect yourself and the athletes, we kindly ask you to use masks in the I-Zone.

E.4 BRIEFING FOR MOVING MEDIA (PHOTOGRAPHERS, TV-TEAMS)

All moving media are requested to attend the briefing sessions in the media centre as follows:

- Main briefing (obligatory for all registered photographers): Tuesday 29.11. 12.15 (2h prior to the race start)
- The daily briefings will take place on each competition day (Wed, Thu, Sat and Sun) 1.5 hours prior to the competition start.

E.5 BIBS FOR THE MOVING MEDIA

All accredited moving media are required to wear a bib in the competition area to get access to the photo zones. These bibs are available i) in the accreditation (TV Rights Holders) and ii) in the media centre in coordination with the IBU Photo Manager. For the bibs distributed in the media centre, a deposit of 20 € must be paid on the spot.

















E.6 PHOTO SERVICE

After each race (after the ceremonies), a selection of still images free from editorial rights restrictions will be made available to all media representatives and media companies. The photos can downloaded for editorial purposes.

E.7 CATERING

The café corner at the media centre will serve soup, snacks and drinks, such as water, coffee, tea, etc. free of charge to accredited media.

E.8 MIXED ZONE

The mixed zone area has several dedicated TV and radio positions for live interviews. There will be a common area for those rights-holding broadcasters who have not booked a dedicated position, as well as for the written Media.

E.9 RADIO FREQUENCIES

The use of certain radio equipment (private mobile radio (PMR), wireless cameras, radio microphones that do not meet licence-free conditions, etc.) requires a radio licence from TRAFICOM. TRAFICOM assigns the frequencies to be used in the licence and it is prohibited to use any other frequencies than those mentioned in the licence.

LICENSE-EXEMPTED EQUIPMENT

Equipment using collective frequencies can be used without a radio licence from TRAFICOM. However, users should be aware that there might be several users on these frequencies and interference may occur. Please, see TRAFICOMs Regulation 15 on collective frequencies for license-exempt radio transmitters (mobile phones, radio microphones, WLAN, etc.). In order to avoid overlapping of frequencies, we kindly ask you to inform the frequencies you will use to YLE/host broadcaster kimmo.verkkosaari@yle.fi Friday 25 Nov latest.

















RADIO INSPECTIONS AND CASES OF RADIO INTERFERENCE

In case of radio interference, please, call: +358 295 345 000 TRAFICOM.

Finnish Transport and Communications Agency (TRAFICOM) controls the use of radio frequencies in Finland and ensures that a sufficient number of frequencies are equally available, in order to ensure all users are able to operate in cooperative and legal manner.

RADIO LICENCE

Each user of a radio transmitter subject to licence must obtain a licence granted by TRAFICOM. TRAFICOM assigns the frequencies to be used. It is prohibited to use any other frequencies than the ones mentioned in the licence. More details and application form can be found at: www.traficom.fi/en



Brown course, 5 x 4.0 km






















Relay Men










