A. GENERAL INFORMATION

A.1 COVID 19 GUIDELINES

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and to ensure your wellbeing, the IBU has established media requirements and rules for the BMW IBU World Cup events.

It is mandatory that you get familiar with these COVID19 guidelines in advance at <u>www.biathlonworld.com/about-ibu/inside-ibu/staysafe/</u>,

Covid19 testing before and during your stay

- To enter Finland, you need to have a valid negative Covid test (not older than 72 hours). After arrival, you have to take the first internal 'on-boarding' test within 24 hours. Second internal test (national requirement) – to be done 72 hours after entering the country.
- You can use the IBU testing infrastructure onsite. For this, please fill in a separate excel sheet (sent to you via email by IBU Media Manager) and indicate your name + time and date of arrival on site in Joensuu. In case of an arrival in FIN before 22.11 please mark also in the last column, if you have already passed/fulfilled the 2nd entry-test required by the Finnish authorities after 72 hours upon arrival in Kontiolahti/Joensuu. The same applies to those who live in Finland, indicate it in the last column.
- A first preliminary test-schedule will be sent out to you and will be confirmed before the event will start. Such schedules will be set up and distributed for each event.



- Positive SARS-CoV-2 test-results/infections of the past (February 2020 until arrival at first IBU event) and all positive results during the season MUST also be reported to the IBU designated COVID-19 contact person (email below).
- You will be invoiced later for the testing. For this, please include your invoice details for the Covid tests to your email (no VAT can be declared, since the IBU is a non-profit organisation). The cost of each test is 70 €.

Please send your email with all the required information, including your phone number, to covid19-wc@ibu.at as soon as possible.

Work at the venue / General COVID19 restrictions (for the full guidelines, see the website and annexes mentioned in the upper part of the page 2).

- Before receiving the results of the second internal test, you are only allowed to stay at the hotel or go to the stadium.
- There will be no media corridor behind the coaches this season.
- Journalists can interview athletes ONLY in the mixed zone, no other places are allowed (even outside of the stadium).
- Press conferences (see chapter E.6 Press Conferences) will be held without media presence. However, you can watch them live on TV screens in the media centre or on your own computer/phone.
- It's mandatory to wear a mask all the time at the venue!
- Keep the distance to others and respect the hygiene rules.
- No handshakes.

A.2 COMPETITION VENUE

Kontiolahti Biathlon Stadium is located on the shores of Lake Höytiäinen in the municipality of Kontiolahti. The stadium is 14 km from the centre of Joensuu and 25 km from Joensuu airport. Kontiolahti Biathlon Stadium is located 120 meters above the sea level. The tracks vary between 89 and 129 meters above the sea level.

C. ACCREDITATION

To receive your accreditation card in the accreditation office, you have to present

- a valid negative COVID19 test result (not older than 72 hours),
- a signed COVID19 declaration of obligations (IBU COVID 19 Guidelines Annex 1 see https://www.biathlonworld.com/about-ibu/inside-ibu/staysafe/) and
- a booking confirmation of the media hotel. If you stay in a different place (only for valid reasons and approved by the OC), you have to provide the exact address and make Covid tests every 48 hours.



There will be two World Cup events in Kontiolahti, the first in the week 48 (27.-29.11.) and the second in the week 49 (3.-6.12). If you wish to participate both events, you have to fulfil the above-mentioned requirements for both weeks.

Please notice that accreditation will be handed out only by providing a negative valid COVID-19 test and after signing the declaration (**IBU's COVID-19 Event Guidelines: Annex 1**). Those tests may not be older than 72h (finally depending on national regulations in the host country).



D. TRANSPORTATION

D.1 TRANSPORTATION FROM AIRPORT/TRAIN STATION

D.2 TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM THE STADIUM

The safest option for travelling to/from the Kontiolahti Biathlon Stadium is to use your own transport. However, if needed, the organiser offers free transportation, too. The media shuttle buses will leave and arrive from/to Joensuu City in front of the media hotels Sokos Hotel Vaakuna ja Hotel Aada. Note! <u>The transport service is based only on requests in advance.</u>

We kindly ask you to leave the requests at the latest one day before the requested transportation.

The estimated driving time in one direction is app. 20 minutes.

E. MEDIA AREAS AND SERVICES

E.1 PARKING IN THE STADIUM

The parking capacity in the stadium is limited during the event. Media has its own parking area close to the media entrance of the Kontiolahti Stadium (see "K. Stadium Map"). Parking permits for the media parking area must be pre-ordered and will be handed out at the accreditation office



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E.2 MEDIA CENTRE

The Media Centre is in a permanent part of the stadium building, and it accommodates two large press conference rooms. Television has its own building close to the media centre.

The centre offers a fast WLAN network and an optional LAN-cabling.


E.3 AVAILABLE MEDIA ZONES (WEARING A MASK IS MANDATORY IN ALL ZONES)

Due to IBU COVID-19 protocols, the following regulations are in place:

- Media representatives will not be able to have direct access to athletes, competition
 areas or team zones (except Mixed Zone). Please note that the IBU COVID-19 protocols
 stipulate that there is no direct contact between the various groups at all including
 outside the biathlon venue. Journalists cannot mingle with other groups and shall limit
 social contacts.
- **Mixed Zone:** There will be a mixed zone with the mandatory distancing corridor for athletes and media.



- Shooting range: There will be no media corridor at the shooting range.
- **Course:** A decision about designated Photo areas on the course will be made closer to the event.
- Media Routes: The venue layout and accessible media zones have changed in comparison to previous events in Kontiolahti. See the map for available media zones (marked with yellow).



E.4 BRIEFING FOR MOVING MEDIA (PHOTOGRAPHERS, TV-TEAMS)

All moving media are requested to attend the briefing sessions in the media centre as follows:

Week 1 (28.-29.11):

• Saturday 28.11.: 10:00 (2h prior to the race start)

Week 2 (3.-6.12.):



• Thursday 3.12.: 12:30 (2 h prior to the race start)

E.5 BIBS FOR THE MOVING MEDIA

All accredited moving media are required to wear a bib in the competition area to get access to the photo zones. These bibs are available in the accreditation (TV Rights Holders) and in the media centre in coordination with the IBU Photo Manager. For the bibs, a deposit of 20 € must be paid on the spot.

Press conferences will be held after each competition as usual, however now you can follow them live on the IBU's official facebook page and on Eurovision Sports' website (which can be reached through the livestream link on biathlonworld.com):

All media representatives and media companies can download a basic package of competition-related pictures as handouts from a new IBU database for editorial purposes. E.7 CATERING


The café corner at the media centre will serve soup, snacks and drinks, such as water, coffee, tea, etc. free of charge to accredited media.

E.8 MIXED ZONE

The Mixed zone is the only place where athletes can be interviewed, no other places are allowed (even outside of the stadium).

The mixed zone area has several dedicated TV and radio positions for live interviews.

The established order of the positions in the mixed zone is shown on the plan below:





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E.9 HB AND RH'S ON VENUE – MCR

The MCR (master control room) will locate in HB truck in TV compound area.

E.10 RADIO FREQUENCIES

The use of certain radio equipment (private mobile radio (PMR), wireless cameras, radio microphones that do not meet licence-free conditions, etc.) requires a radio licence from TRAFICOM. TRAFICOM assigns the frequencies to be used in the licence and it is prohibited to use any other frequencies than those mentioned in the licence.

LICENSE-EXEMPTED EQUIPMENT

Equipment using collective frequencies can be used without a radio licence from TRAFICOM. However, users should be aware that there might be several users on these frequencies and interference may occur. Please, see TRAFICOMs Regulation 15 on collective frequencies for license-exempt radio transmitters (mobile phones, radio microphones, WLAN, etc.). In order to avoid overlapping of frequencies, we kindly ask you to inform media@kontiolahtibiathlon.com the frequencies you will use.

RADIO INSPECTIONS AND CASES OF RADIO INTERFERENCE

In case of radio interference, please, call: +358 295 345 000 TRAFICOM.

Finnish Transport and Communications Agency (TRAFICOM) controls the use of radio frequencies in Finland and ensures that a sufficient number of frequencies are equally available, in order to ensure all users are able to operate in cooperative and legal manner.

RADIO LICENCE

Each user of a radio transmitter subject to licence must obtain a licence granted by TRAFICOM. TRAFICOM assigns the frequencies to be used. It is prohibited to use any other frequencies than the ones mentioned in the licence. More details and application form can be found at: www.traficom.fi/en

E.11 FILMING AND DISTRIBUTION OF FOOTAGE RULES

No filming from the official IBU competition areas (e.g. race track, from the warm-up area up to and including the finish area, mixed zone) is permitted in the time window commencing one (1) hour before the beginning of the first competition of the competition day (warm-up, zeroing, etc.) and ending with the press conference of the last competition of the competition day.

No footage from the official IBU competition areas (e.g. race track, from the warm-up area up to and including the finish area, mixed zone) that was filmed in the period starting one (1) hour before the start of the first competition on the competition day (warm-up, zeroing, etc.) up to, and including, the press conference of the last competition of the competition day may be distributed on any platforms, including but not limited to social medias.

Filming and distribution of footage of all other activities and areas around the competition is allowed.

Before the press conference, the activities in the finish area/mixed zone (interviews with TV stations etc.) may not be affected under any circumstances.
